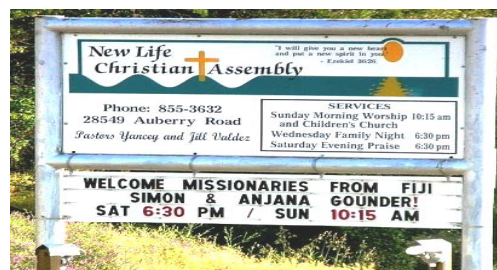
Marching On
